Teacher certification is valid when issued, and it remains valid for four years. The Teacher Certification Exam (TCE) is administered annually and is mandated by the Texas Education Code. The Texas Legislature authorized the Texas Education Agency (TEA) to license teachers in 1997, and the TCE replaced the general education licensing requirement in 1999. The TCE covers the standards established in the Texas Education Code and is used to issue a license to teaching certification candidates. During the TCE examination period, applicants who have not been registered may test multiple times until they pass the exam, or they may apply to have their scores sealed. In addition, the TCE is administered to licensees who have been in continuous employment for the four-year period. The TCE is administered annually for a period of four years and is mandated by the Texas Education Code. Each applicant must submit the application form in order to begin the TCE. Once the application is received by the TEA, the agency assigns a new testing date. The assignment date is used to calculate the applicant's registration period, and the application is processed.
